- 1 Prosecco, Borgo Sanleo, NV Italy **£6.50 / £23.95**
Intense floral, fruity bouquet. A wonderfully fresh and well-balanced, appley palate with just a hint of delicate almond. (1) 11% vol
- 2 Skinny Prosecco, NV Italy **£7.50 / £38.95**
A top class Prosecco designed for those wanting quality whilst cutting sugar. Produced from grapes grown on the south-facing slopes of the foothills of the Dolomites in north-east Italy. It is dry, refreshing but with the classic Prosecco flavours and just as fun. Certified organic and vegan too. (1) 11% vol
- 3 Paul Herard Blanc de Noirs Brut, NV Champagne, France **£39.00**
Brut, but with sunny fruit flavours and a fresh appley edge. (1) 12% vol
- 4 Laurent-Perrier La Cuvee Brut, NV Champagne, France **£60.00**
In the top rank of Champagne houses, the style is light and elegant. Real finesse tops yeasty, fresh bread undertones, taut apple and citrus fruit. Complex, absolute purity. (1) 12% vol
- 5 Moët & Chandon Brut Imperial, NV Champagne, France **£62.00**
Possibly the most well known of all Champagnes worldwide. Classic, old fashioned style. (1) 12% vol
- 6 Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut, NV Champagne, France **£75.00**
Pale gold, confident full aroma and flavour, mouth-filling and satisfying. Excellent in its class with real depth of flavour. (1) 12% vol
- 7 Dom Perignon, 2006 Champagne, France **£180.00**
Reputedly the oldest and most traditional of all Champagnes. Very delicate style to savour. One of the greats. (1) 12.5% vol

- 8 Rosato Spumante Botter, NV Italy **£26.00**
Dazzling pink fizz that is soft and well-balanced on the palate, with a sherbet cherry touch. (2) 11% vol
- 9 Duval - Leroy Rose, Brut NV **£55.00**
Beautiful salmon-pink colour with a fine mousse, gorgeous fruit flavour and rich mouth-filling palate.
- 10 Moët & Chandon Rosé Brut, NV Champagne, France **£76.00**
Both brut and rosé with a real flavour reward from the new era Moët. (1) 12% vol
- 11 Bollinger Rosé Brut, NV Champagne, France **£86.00**
Created from Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier, showing delicate aromas of ripe red fruits and powerful elegance. It is immensely complex and utterly wonderful. (1) 12% vol
- 12 Laurent-Perrier Rosé La Cuvee Brut, NV Champagne, France **£89.00**
Pale and interesting, yet full and flavoursome. A classic wine in an iconic bottle. (1) 12% vol

- 13 Pinot Grigio, Laroma, Botter, 2016/17 Venetie, Italy **£4.95 / £17.95**
Fresh, dry and delicate with gentle floral and citrus aromas. A classic Italian white wine. (2) 12% vol
- 14 Chardonnay, Esencia de Fontana, 2016/17 Uclés, Spain **£4.95 / £17.95**
Elegant aromas of ripe orchard fruits with subtle mineral notes. Medium-bodied with good concentration and a juicy mouthfeel, supported by fresh acidity. No over-oaked heavy 1980s style Chardonnay here! (2) 13.5% vol
- 15 Sauvignon-Semillon, San Elian, 2016/17 Central Valley, Chile **£4.95 / £17.95**
On the nose, tropical fruit aromas whilst on the palate, citrus flavours, a light body and a balanced acidit. (2) 12.5% vol
- 16 Chenin Blanc, Lion Ridge, 2016/17 Western Cape, South Africa **£4.95 / £17.95**
Leaps out of its skin with zesty lemon tropical freshness followed on by more rounded melon flavours. (3) 13% vol
- 17 Viognier, Lion Ridge, 2016/17 Swartland, South Africa **£20.95**
This unwooded style of Viognier offers a dry but fruity style. The floral bouquet greets the nose and follows through with lovely tropical flavours on a lingering palate. (2) 13.5% vol
- 18 Sauvignon Blanc, Honores de Berticot, 2016/17 IGP de l'Atlantique, France **£5.95 / £21.50**
Grassy, dry Sauvignon from western France, with a pleasing, crisp, neat finish. (1) 11.5% vol
- 19 Fiano Lunate, Botter, 2015/16 Sicily, Italy **£21.50**
One for the senses; deep golden colour, tropical aromatics and a palate that bursts with flavours of mango and pineapple. Crisp, dry and harmonious. (1) 13.5% vol
- 20 Vipra Bianca Grechetto-Chardonnay Umbria, bigi, Italy **£20.95**
A Grechetto and Chardonnay blend, showing gentle, white peach and pear flavours.
- 21 Torres San Valentin, Penedes Spain **£21.50**
From 100% Parellada grapes to produce a slightly off-dry white with a fresh and fruity character.
- 22 Don Jacobo Rioja Blanco, Bodegas Corral Spain **£21.50**
Fresh, dry, crisp and modern, from this classic Spanish region using the local Uva grape.
- 23 Destinea Sauvignon Blanc, Val de Loire, Joseph Mellot France **£21.50**
Fondly known as a "little Sancerre". Young vines give seductive hints of a grapefruit and gooseberries.
- 24 September Hills Chardonnay, California **£23.95**
Tropical fruit notes with a crisp toasty oak, fresh apple and pear fruit aromas
- 25 Veramonte Sauvignon Blanc Reserva, Casablanc Valley, Chile **£24.95**
Fresh cut grass, gooseberries with a fine aroma.
- 26 Riesling, The Naked Grape, 2015/16 Pfalz, Germany **£24.95**
Medium style wine with lovely peachy flavours and a hint of apricot. Showing the purity of Riesling, this harmonious wine is worth discovering and enjoying with seafood and shellfish or as an aperitif. (3) 11% vol
- 27 Gewürztraminer Reserva, Aves del Sur, 2015/16 Maule Valley, Chile **£25.95**
Characteristic and intense nose of rose petals with notes of lychee and orange blossom. Sweet melon and fresh citrus fruit give balance to the palate. Long, persistent finish. (2) 13.5% vol
- 28 Dart Valley Reserve, 2015/16 Sharpham, Devon, England **£28.95**
Super full-flavoured, zippy estate wine. Energetic and with all the structure for a long and happy life. (2) 11% vol
- 29 Sauvignon Blanc, Esk Valley, 2014/15 Marlborough, New Zealand **£33.95**
Very lean and grassy with a mineral, citrus zing. It has an added complexity of asparagus pungency and bright nettle notes. Absolutely classic benchmark Sauvignon. (1) 13% vol
- 30 Chablis, Paul Deloux, France **£33.95**
Flavorful, lively, fresh and mouth-watering with a crisp, fruity palate and that flinty backbone only found in true Chablis.
- 31 Bourgogne Chardonnay Couvent des Jacobins, Louis Jadot France **£34.95**
Generous richness laden with butter coated peaches, mature barrique character exudes a mouth-filling roundness.
- 32 Sancerre, La Graveliere, Joseph Mellot, France **£35.95**
Vibrant, aromatic Sauvignon Blanc at its best, opulent on the nose and palate, stylishly dry on the finish.
- 33 Chablis 1er Cru Les Vaudevay, Domaine Laroche, 2014/15 Chablis, Burgundy, France **£49.95**
The elegant biscuit and brioche aroma is fitting of its 'Premier Cru' status. Fine fruit flavour with the merest hint of oak to round out the citrus notes and extend the finish. (2) 13% vol

Connoisseurs Choice

- 34 Oakridge Lusatia Park Chardonnay, Yarra Valley, Australia **£56.00**
Chardonnay is the grape that has perhaps grabbed the most attention of all the wines made at Oakridge. Dave Bicknell, the winemaker, takes the same approach here as with his other wines; Minimal intervention is the key, providing the best conditions for the wine to make itself. The Palate is rich and almost opulent with a fruit salad, green melon, quince and toffee apple character, supported by a fine, long acidity and strong citrus tang. James Halliday gave the 2009 - 95 points and the 2010 - 96 points in the 2011 and 2012 editions of his Australian Wine Companion.

Red Wines

- 35 Merlot-Cabernet Sauvignon, San Elian, 2016/17 Central Valley, Chile **£4.95 / £17.95**
On the nose, aromas of black cherries, whilst on the palate, juicy red and black fruits combine with a medium body and oft tannins. (B) 13% vol
- 36 Syrah, Esencia de Fontana, 2015/16 Uclés, Spain **£4.95 / £17.95**
Intense fruit character of a sunny climate with definition and freshness given by the high-altitude vineyard. Full-bodied and juicy with fine tannins and a refreshing finish. This is really very good. (C) 14.5% vol
- 37 Cabernet Sauvignon, Rue des Amis, 2016/17 Languedoc, France **£4.95 / £17.95**
Dark ruby red with a powerful bouquet of ripe fruit with hints of herbs and spice. Firm and round to taste with structured length. (C) 13% vol
- 38 Malbec, Rue des Amis, 2016/17 Languedoc, France **£5.95 / £18.95**
Deep ruby in colour, this is an approachable tyle of this increasingly popular variety. Intense red fruit aromas lead on to a smooth and easy-drinking palate. (C) 12.5% vol
- 39 Merlot, Honoré de Berticot, 2015/16 IGP de l'Atlantique, France **£5.25 / £21.50**
No heaviness, here is a light supple Merlot that takes its cue from many traditional light wines made in neighbouring Bordeaux. (C) 12.5% vol
- 40 Primitivo-Negroamaro, Gran Rosso, 2015/16 Salento, Italy **£21.95**
Intense, full and complex with dark chocolate and black cherry character. A wonderful food wine with plenty of body and structure for hearty dishes. (C) 13.5% vol
- 41 Côtes du Rhône, Les Bastilles, France **£22.50**
Rich and generous with a distinctive peppery finish, from the southern Rhône valley.
- 42 Rare Vineyards Pinot Noir, Vin de France **£23.00**
From the foothills of the Pyrenees, soft, lightly oaked cherries and blueberries with a hint of spice.
- 43 Chianti Riserva, Trambusti, Italy **£24.45**
Specially selected grapes, aged for longer to achieve a smoother more integrated classic Chianti. Warm red fruits with light spice and vanilla undertones.
- 44 Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Valle Reale, Italy **£25.00**
Deliciously rustic with black cherry and plum flavours and notes of dark chocolate.
- 45 Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva, Aves del Sur, 2014/15 Maule Valley, Chile **£25.00**
Intense red cherry hue with complex aromas of red fruits, vanilla and coffee. A full, rich palate with flavours of blackberries, blueberries and cassis mixed with delicate toasted notes from barrel ageing. A well-made wine with a long and fruity finish. (C) 13.5% vol
- 46 Malbec, The Butcher of Buenos Aires, NV Argentina **£26.00**
Attractive notes of sweet black cherry and a silky smooth mouthfeel. Not a heavy Malbec but one designed to be versatile with food, easy enough to drink on its own and yet perfect, of course, with a good steak. (C) 13% vol
- 47 Don Jacobo Rioja Crianza Tinto, Bodegas Corral, Spain **£27.00**
Abundant bright raspberry aromas mingle with sumptuous cherries and layered with a creamy barrique character.
- 48 Beaujolais Villages, Combe aux Jacques, Louis Jabot **£28.00**
Expressive Beaujolais with bright cherry and spice. Lots of juicy fruit with a soft smooth finish.
- 49 Red Knot Grenanche-Shiraz-Mourvedere, McLaren Vale, Australia **£30.00**
Enticing primary aromas of dark cherry, raspberry and rose are highlighted with deeper notes of liquorice and chocolate
- 50 Château de Barbe, Cotes de Bourg, France **£31.00**
Fleshy and structured, showing ripe plum and blackcurrant fruit, with floral notes on the finish
- 51 Pinot Noir, Taringi, 2013/14 Marlborough, New Zealand **£32.00**
Deliciously scented with ripe berry fruit. Smooth tannins and a touch of spice provide texture to a fruit-led palate. (B) 12.5% vol
- 52 Waipara Hills Pinot Noir, Central Otato, New Zealand **£33.00**
Bramble fruit, cherry, spice and a hint of smoke on the nose, black cherry and plum on the palate supported by vanilla spice.
- 53 ViBo Red, Viñedo Centenario, Viu Manent, 2011/12 Colchagua Valley, Chile **£35.00**
A deliciously rounded red with bold ripe fruits, subtle spice notes, and an elegant lifted finish. (D) 14.5% vol
- 54 Côte de Beaune-Villages Réserve des Jacobins, Louis Jabot, France **£37.50**
A more feminine and certainly seductive style. Cherry blossom aromas mingle with gentle hints of spiced barrique character.
- 55 Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Les Cornalines, France **£43.00**
Traditions ensure heady aromas of spices and a long velvet character laden with warm fruit cake flavours.

Connoisseurs Choice

- 56 The Federalist Zinfandel, Dry Creek Valley, America **£56.00**
Parcels of Zinfandel from Dry Creek Valley vineyards, just about perfect for growing this grape, were fermented separately to preserve the characteristics of each; the average length of time on the skins was 17 days. After pressing and malolactic fermentation in barrels, the wine was matured for 15 months in a mixture of French and American oak barrels (25% new). Fruit forward with blackberry and black cherry aromas and spicy notes; the palate is balanced and mouth-filling with a rich texture and long finish.

- 57 Zinfandel Rosé, Terrazzo, 2016/17 California, USA **£4.95 / £17.95**
Bright pink in colour, it bursts with juicy melon, raspberry and apple notes, held in check with a streak of lemon-lime acidity. (S) 9% vol
- 58 Pinot Grigio Rosato, Laroma, Botter, 2014/15 Pavia, Italy **£4.95 / £17.95**
As pleasing a Pinot Grigio rosé as you could find. It has freshness, delicacy and rose-scented charm all the way through. (2) 12% vol
- 59 Sables d'Azur Rosé, 2016/17 Côtes de Provence, France **£21.95**
Classic Côtes de Provence rosé. Salmon coloured, elegant nose of white flowers, summer fruits and citrus with crisp acidity and delicate finish. (2) 13% vol

Dessert Wines

- 60 Concha Y Toro Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc, Maule Valley, Chile **£5.45 (75ml) / £18.95**
Sumptuous, sweet wine with ripe papaya, peach and honey aromas. Light, fresh and fruity with a long, subtle, honeyed finish.
- 61 Muscat de St Jean de Minervois, Domaine Les Tailhades, 2012/13 South of France **£5.45 / £18.95**
Expressive sweet wine, with dried apricot, exotic fruit, rose flower and orange peel aromas. Rich in the mouth with honey and citrus fruit notes on the finish. (8) 15% vol
- 62 Rutherglen Muscat, Campbells, NV Victoria, Australia **£5.50 / £25.00**
Spirit and aged oak character tints. Intense Muscat aroma and fresh raisin fruit backed by a hint of fortifying spirit and amber gold characters. Lusciously sweet. (9) 17.5% vol
- 63 Nederburg Winemakers Reserve Noble Late Harvest, South Africa **£6.75 (75ml) / £29.00**
Brilliant gold with lime-green highlights; it shows aromas of honey, pineapple, dried apricot with floral and spice notes; the palate is bursting with flavour and well-balanced with a long finish.
- 64 Noble One Botrytis Semillon, De Bortoli, 2011/12 N.S.W., Australia **£6.75 / £29.00**
Perfect expression of Australian botrytised Semillon, this wine has a golden tawny colour and glorious aroma. Unctuous, viscous, concentrated sweetness. Extraordinary. (8) 11% vol
