### White Wines by the Glass

175ml Glass/Bottle

- 1 Pinot Grigio di Pavia, Collezione Marchesini, Italy £4.95/ £17.95  
*Lovely buttery, crisp and dry style with typical pear fruit from this area of central northern Italy in the southern section of Lombardy*
- 2 The Riddle Colombard-Chardonnay, SE Australia £4.95/ £17.95  
*Easy-drinking and refreshingly lively. Zingy Colombard character and fuller, richer style Chardonnay. All fermented in stainless steel with no oak contact.*
- 3 Tierra Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley Chile £4.95/ £17.95  
*Pale yellow with fresh fruit, citrus and mineral notes and a clean finish.*
- 4 Oben Grove Riesling-Gewürztraminer, Rhein £4.95/ £17.95  
*Aromatic lime and apples with the soft sweetness of a peach and cherry blossom.*

### Rosé Wines by the Glass

- 5 Vendange White Zinfandel, California, USA £4.95/ £17.95  
*A brief time with juice and skin together gives this delicate colour, delicious strawberry aroma and zingy freshness.*
- 6 Pinot Grigio, Provincia Di Pavia, Italy £4.95/ £17.95  
*Fresh and versatile Italian wine with ripe flavours of the peach and strawberry*

### Red Wines by the Glass

- 7 Tierra Merlot, Central Valley, Chile £4.95/ £17.95  
*Ripe blackberry aromas and a subtle underlay of oak with bright, ripe berry flavours and smooth tannins.*
- 8 The Riddle Shiraz-Cabernet, SE Australia £4.95/ £17.95  
*Spicy pepper, raspberry and cherry of the Shiraz and the blackcurrant, capsicum and mint of the Cabernet. Lightly oaked, soft and mellow.*
- 9 Robert Mondavi Twin Oakes Cabernet Sauvignon, California £5.95/ £19.45  
*The long, dry and very hot late summers allow lovely flavours to develop. Vibrant redcurrants and a spiced oak balance.*

### White Champagne & Sparkling Wine

- 10 Prosecco 'Special Cuvée', Sant Orsola, Italy, NV £23.95  
*Light and lively, with ripe pears and lemons rounded off with a hint of sweetness.*
- 11 Bottega Gold Prosecco Brut, Italy £38.95  
*Characteristic, fruity with scents of golden apple, Williams pear, acacia flowers and lily of the valley.*
- 12 Louis Dornier et Fils Brut, NV £39.00  
*A light, fresh, vigorously youthful Champagne with a fine, elegant, slightly lemony nose, lively mousse and long, crisp palate..*
- 13 Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial, NV £60.00  
*A well known blend of older reserves with young wines to ensure a consistency of this flowery aroma and warm biscuit hints.*
- 14 Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut, NV £75.00  
*Reflecting the traditions of the past, this is full, yet dry and has a rich, creamy style with biscuity flavours.*
- 15 Dom Pérignon Brut, 2002 £180.00  
*Long and satisfying on the palate with layers of yeasty, nutty flavours, superbly fat and ripe. Complex, luxury Grand Cru Champagne made only in the best years.*

### Rosé Champagne & Sparkling Wine

- 16 Pinot Cuvée Rosé Brut, Casa Sant' Orsola, Italy NV £26.00  
*Fashionably pink this pear fizz is light, dry and refreshing.*
- 17 Bottega Rose Gold, Italy £43.00  
*Notes of mixed red berries alongside floral and white fruit aromas.*
- 18 Duval – Leroy Rosé, Brut NV £66.00  
*Beautiful salmon-pink colour with a fine mousse, gorgeous fruit flavour and rich mouth-filling palate.*
- 19 Moët & Chandon Rosé Impérial £76.00  
*Salmon-pink in colour, this has a wonderful fresh, floral style with summer strawberry flavours.*
- 20 Bollinger Rosé £86.00  
*A stunning rosé that has aromas of cherries, strawberries and a touch of cinnamon. Mouth-filling vibrant flavours of toast and brioche with hints of almonds combine to create one of the finest rosé Champagnes available.*

### White Wines

- 21 Vipra Bianca Grechetto-Chardonnay Umbria, Bigi, Italy £20.95  
*A Grechetto and Chardonnay blend, showing gentle, white peach and pear flavours.*
- 22 Torres San Valentin, Penedes Spain £21.50  
*From 100% Parellada grapes to produce a slightly off-dry white with a fresh and fruity character.*
- 23 Don Jacobo Rioja Blanco, Bodegas Corral Spain £21.50  
*Fresh, dry, crisp and modern, from this classic Spanish region using the local Viura grape.*
- 24 Destinée Sauvignon Blanc, Val de Loire, Joseph Mellot France £21.50  
*Fondly known as a "little Sancerre". Young vines give seductive hints of a grapefruit and gooseberries.*
- 25 Kleinne Zalze Bush Vines, Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch S.Africa, £21.50  
*Soft and creamy, a hint of ripe exotic fruit and a delicious vanilla sweetness.*
- 26 Flagstone Noon Gun Chenin Blanc-Sauvignon Blanc-Viognier £22.50  
*Intense, aromatic, tropical fruit flavours spiked with a wedge of orange peel and a sprinkling of baking spice.*
- 27 September Hills Chardonnay, California £23.95  
*Tropical fruit notes with a crisp toasty oak, fresh apple and pear fruit aromas*
- 28 Veramonte Sauvignon Blanc Reserva, Casablanc Valley, Chile £24.95  
*Fresh cut grass, gooseberries with a fine aroma.*
- 29 Fortant de France Terroir Littoral Chardonnay, Pays d'Oc £26.50  
*Lively and fresh with intense aromas of citrus and exotic fruits on the finish.*
- 30 Bethany G6 Riesling, Barossa Valley £31.00  
*Attractive brilliant pale green-gold colour and varietal citrus aromas lead on to a lean, refined lemony palate with delicate floral overtones.*
- 31 Chablis, Paul Deloux, France £33.95  
*Flowery, lively, fresh and mouth-watering with a crisp, fruity palate and that flinty backbone only found in true Chablis.*
- 32 Drylands Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand £33.95  
*Sensational aromatic Sauvignon. Grapefruit and gooseberries lead into vibrant fresh cut grass, gooseberries and tropical fruit and crisp, refreshing finish.*
- 33 Bourgogne Chardonnay Couvent des Jacobins, Louis Jadot France £34.95  
*Generous richness laden with butter coated peaches, mature barrique character exudes a mouth-filling roundness.*
- 34 Sancerre, La Graveliere, Joseph Mellot, France £35.95  
*Vibrant, aromatic Sauvignon Blanc at its best, opulent on the nose and palate, stylishly dry on the finish.*

### Connoisseurs Choice

- 35 Oakridge Lusatia Park Chardonnay, Yarra Valley, Australia £56.00  
*Chardonnay is the grape that has perhaps grabbed the most attention of all the wines made at Oakridge. Dave Bicknell, the winemaker, takes the same approach here as with his other wines; Minimal intervention is the key, providing the best conditions for the wine to make itself. The Palate is rich almost opulent with a fruit salad, green melon, quince and toffee apple character, supported by a fine, long acidity and strong citrus tang. James Halliday gave the 2009 - 95 points and the 2010 - 96 points in the 2011 and 2012 editions of his Australian Wine Companion.*

### Red Wines

- 36 Rare Vineyards Malbec Pays d'Oc, France £19.95  
*Having achieved fame in Argentina, Malbec returns home. Lovely violet aromas, solid fruit flavours and a splash of spiced oak.*
- 37 The Gourmet Shiraz, South Australia £21.45  
*Restrained blackberry fruit backed by a crisp finish.*
- 38 Côtes du Rhône, Les Bastilles, France £22.50  
*Rich and generous with a distinctive peppery finish, from the southern Rhône valley.*
- 39 Rare Vineyards Pinot Noir, Vin de France £23.00  
*From the foothills of the Pyrenees, soft, lightly oaked cherries and blueberries with a hint of spice.*
- 40 Chianti Riserva, Trambusti, Italy £24.45  
*Specially selected grapes, aged for longer to achieve a smoother more integrated classic Chianti. Warm red fruits with light spice and vanilla undertones.*
- 41 Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Valle Reale, Italy £25.00  
*Deliciously rustic with black cherry and plum flavours and notes of dark chocolate.*
- 42 Kleine Zalze Vineyard Selection Cabernet Sauvignon, Stellenbosch, South Africa £25.00  
*Grapes harvested from 30-year-old vines ensure this depth of blackcurrant richness coupled with a soft vanilla barrique character.*
- 43 Callia Reservado Malbec, San Juan, £26.00  
*Rich and powerful Malbec, good concentration of blackberry, plum and herbal flavours alongside medium oak.*
- 44 Don Jacobo Rioja Crianza Tinto, Bodegas Corral, Spain £27.00  
*Abundant bright raspberry aromas mingle with sumptuous cherries and layered with a creamy barrique character.*
- 45 Beaujolais Villages, Combe aux Jacques, Louis Jabot £28.00  
*Expressive Beaujolais with bright cherry and spice. Lots of juicy fruit with a soft, smooth finish.*
- 46 Red Knot Grenache-Shiraz-Mourvedere, McLaren Vale, Australia £30.00  
*Enticing primary aromas of dark cherry, raspberry and rose are highlighted with deeper notes of liquorice and chocolate*
- 47 Château de Barbe, Cotes de Bourg, France £31.00  
*Fleshy and structured, showing ripe plum and blackcurrant fruit, with floral notes on the finish*
- 48 Waipara Hills Pinot Noir, Central Otato, New Zealand £33.00  
*Bramble fruit, cherry, spice and a hint of smoke on the nose; black cherry and plum on the palate supported by vanilla spice.*
- 49 Côte de Beaune-Villages Réserve des Jacobins, Louis Jabot, France £37.50  
*A more feminine and certainly seductive style. Cherry blossom aromas mingle with gentle hints of spiced barrique character.*
- 50 Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Les Cornalines, France £43.00  
*Traditions ensure heady aromas of spices and a long velvet character laden with warm fruit cake flavours.*

### Connoisseurs Choice

- 51 The Federalist Zinfandel, Dry Creek Valley, America £56.00  
*Parcels of Zinfandel from Dry Creek Valley vineyards, just about perfect for growing this grape, were fermented separately to preserve the characteristics of each; the average length of time on the skins was 17 days. After pressing and malolactic fermentation in barrels, the wine was matured for 15 months in a mixture of French and American oak barrels (25% new). Fruit forward with blackberry and black cherry aromas and spicy notes; the palate is balanced and mouth-filling with a rich texture and long finish.*

### Dessert Wines

- 52 Concha Y Toro Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc, Maule Valley, Chile £5.45 (75ml)/ £18.95  
*Sumptuous, sweet wine with ripe papaya, peach and honey aromas. Light, fresh and fruity with a long, subtle, honeyed finish.*
- 53 Nederburg Winemakers Reserve Noble Late Harvest, South Africa £6.75 (75ml)/ £29.00  
*Brilliant gold with lime-green highlights; it shows aromas of honey, pineapple, dried apricot with floral and spice notes: the palate is bursting with flavour and well-balanced with a long finish.*
